Report on International Conference

Clara's College of Commerce organized International Conference on 16th March 2019 in the Fifth Floor Hall from 9.00am to 5.00pm. The topic for the conference was "World road to Cashless Economy". A cashless society describes an economic state whereby financial transactions are not conducted with money in the form of physical banknotes or coins, but rather through the transfer of digital information (usually an electronic representation of money) between the transacting parties. Cashless societies have existed from the time when human society came into existence, based on barter and other methods of exchange, and cashless transactions have also become possible in modern times. The term 'cashless Economy' moves towards a society where cash is replaced by its digital equivalent - in other words, legal tender (money) exists and is exchanged only in electronic digital form. So it is a need of an hour to discuss such a current change and boom. By keeping this view in mind, the college organized a conference on the said topic.

- The cover page of the manuscript must contain the title of the paper, author's name/ co-author name, correspondence address, e-mail ID, Contact No and acknowledgements, if any. The cover page should not be the part of the paper so as to facilitate peer review of the paper.
- References should be given at the end of the paper and should be as per the APA style. In case of website references, the entire URL should be provided by authors. (Soft copy of the research paper must be sent by email).
- **Plagiarism Check report & Declaration must be attached in the Annexure.**
