Economic trends and Market Analysis are addressed on Day 9, providing participants with tools to interpret market dynamics and make informed investment decisions. The program culminates in a comprehensive wrap-up and Review on Day 10, allowing participants to reflect on their learning journey and solidify their understanding of key concepts. Through this structured approach, participants emerge with heightened financial literacy and the confidence to navigate various aspects of personal finance adeptly.

3. Learning outcome:

Participants in the course gained essential skills in personal finance, including budgeting, banking, credit management, and investment strategies. They learned to analyze stock market trends, plan for retirement, optimize financial planning, and interpret economic indicators. 
- Food committee


Activity 1:-Session on 'Soft skills'



Activity 2:- Session on Communal Harmony



Activity 3:-Workshop on Disaster Management



Activity 4:- Workshop on Street Play



play was also made known to the students. Active participation and motivation amongst the students was generated by Mr.Sandesh Lalge.




Activity 5:-Swatchaa Bharat Abhiyan


Activity 6:- Rally


Activity 7:- Street Play on AndhashraddhaNirmulan and Excessive use of Mobiles by students

Activity 9: Visit to Anathashram


