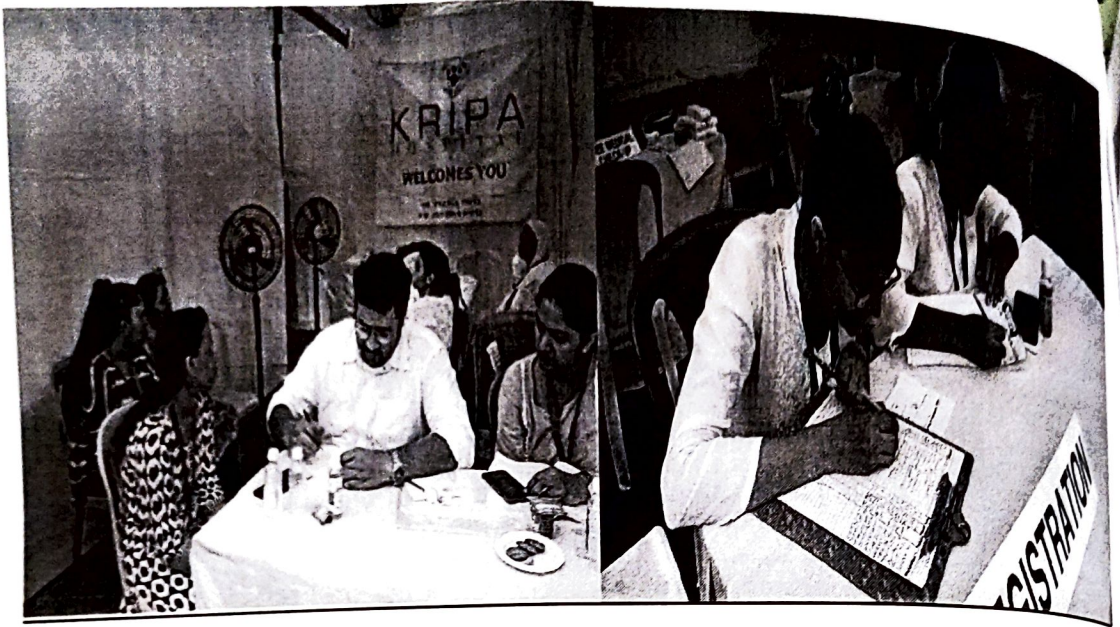
Outcome:

Report on Online Celebration of World Environment Day

Clara's College of Commerce celebrated 'World Environment Day' on 5th June 2021 through zoom app from 11.00am to 12.30pm. A guest lecture was organized on the occasion of World Environment Day on the topic 'Ecosystem Restoration'. The speaker was Mr. Reetesh Singh from our own college. The programme began with the brief introduction of the programme by Mr. Shripad Joshi. Principal Dr. Madhukar Gitte Formally Started the programme by introducing the concept Ecosystem and sustainability and talked on the ways to protect the environment.

The speaker Mr. Reetesh Singh in his lecture elaborated the concept "Ecosystem". He stressed on the fact that the social agents can play a vital role in restoring ecosystem. An individual has to take initiative to protect the environment. He said that one should not shoulder a responsibility on government all the time. Moreover, he also reiterated the role of government in restoring ecosystem. He underscore the fact that the collective work of all human beings can save mother earth.

Mr. Reetesh while discussing the concept 'Ecological restoration' stated that it is the process of repairing sites in nature whose biological communities and ecosystems have been degraded or destroyed. In many ecosystems, humans have altered local native populations of plants and animals introduced invasive species, converted natural communities to extractive use (such as agriculture or mining), fouled waters, and degraded soil resources. He stated that Ecological restoration focuses on repairing the damage human activities have caused to natural ecosystems and seeks to return them to an earlier state or to another state that is closely related to one unaltered by human activities.

Mr. Reetesh Singh was of the opinion that the restoration process begins with an assessment of the degraded site. The current site conditions should be thoroughly examined to identify the need for restoration and any potential actions required to restore the site. In case of Restoring Ecosystem one has to study nature and its different resources. He remarked that the Restorationists should consider the causes of degradation can be reversed or lessened and the ways in which restoration can be accomplished. He also marked the point that human being need to change life style favoring the environment. There has to be balance between environment and the development of mankind.

Mr. Shripad Joshi coordinated the programme. Mr. Ajay Kulkarni Sir, secretary and Mr. Prashant Kashid Sir, Activity Chairman encouraged faculty to conduct a programme and helped in smooth execution of it. 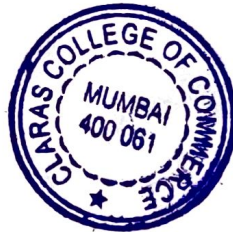

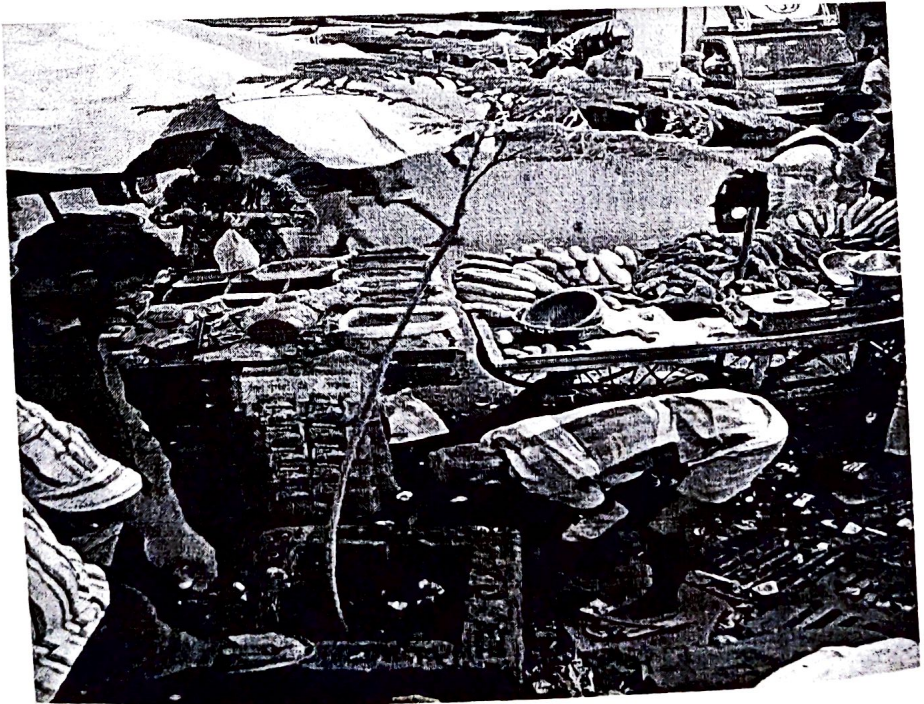
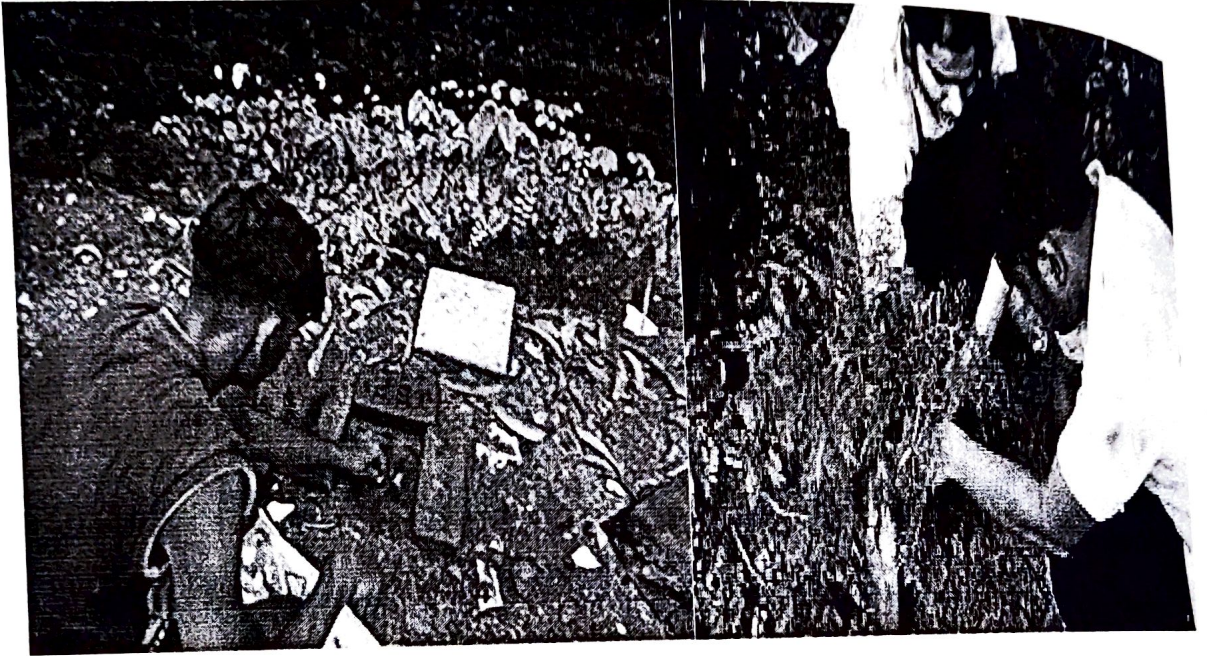
