





Indeed, it was a day of joy, a day to love and respect our country and make it a better place for Indians to live and experience the freedom, peace and unity in diversity.



Objective - The objective of the blood donation drive is to create awareness and motivate people, students for Blood Donation and to help anyone, in case of any requirement for blood.







Activity 1:- Workshop on 'Street Play and Team Building'



Fire poses a tremendous safety risk for any business, workplace or organization one of the biggest safety issues we see, in fact, yet one that is sometimes overlooked or underestimated. An important aspect of any prevention process requires the full awareness of the risks and impacts. Fire safety awareness is the important starting point in an integrated fire safety plan for every business.

With an objective to create awareness about fire safety and the usage of fire extinguishing equipment, A Virtual training on Fire Safety was organized by NSS up in collaboration with BCOM and BAF departments of Clara's College of Commercial on July 22, 2021. - Type D- Caused due to rise in temperature of various metals
- Type E- Caused due to short-circuit in any electric equipment
