## **Report**

The IQAC department of Clara's College of Commerce organised a session on First Aid Training for teaching and non-teaching staff on 21st June, 2025 at 11:30 a.m. in Hall, 5th floor.

The session began with the welcome and felicitation of Dr. Chetana Sawant. She provided information on how to handle certain emergency situations, such as when someone faints or has an epileptic seizure, until help arrives. CPR was explained and demonstrated in detail. Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) is a critical emergency procedure that can save lives. Begin by assessing the situation—ensure the area is safe, check for responsiveness, and call emergency services (Dial 108). If the person is unresponsive and not breathing or only gasping, start CPR. For adults, place the heel of one hand on the center of the chest with the other hand on top, and give 100–120 compressions per minute, about 2 inches deep. If trained, provide two rescue breaths after every 30 compressions. Use an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) if available, follow its prompts, and continue CPR until help arrives. The session was very interactive and informative.


program concluded with a **vote of thanks** delivered by Ms. Kajal Jaiswal, Ma'am, marking the end of a meaningful and inspiring session.

to look after the planted saplings, plant more and more trees and encourage others to do the same.



**Objectives:** To prevent any physical or mental torture or any disorderly conduct towards any student causing apprehension, dread, humiliation, or agitation in him or her.

**Organizer:** IQAC & Anti Ragging Committee

**Report:** An Awareness Session on Anti-Ragging was held on Wednesday 16th July, 2025 for FY, SY and TY Students. Ms. Kajal Jaiswal was the resource person for the session.

Ms. Kajal Jaiswal has explained that the Anti-Ragging Committee of the institution shall take an appropriate decision, with regard to punishment or otherwise, depending on the facts of each incident of ragging and nature and gravity of the incident of ragging.

#### **College will take the following action in case of ragging:**

- Debarring from admission to any other institution of the University.
- Withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
- Debarring from appearing for the examination.
- Debarring from representing the College in sports and cultural events.

This Orientation Programme was organised for fresher's and parents to familiarize them with the institutional rules and regulations inclusive of anti-ragging measures, what constitutes ragging and the consequences to be faced. The 'Anti-Ragging Awareness Programme' aimed at making students aware of the laws of the country with respect to ragging and how it affects the lives of students victimized by it. If ragging is not terminated at any point, the victims get so scared that they are not able to focus on their studies; so, it affects their career; the sufferer may even quit the college education due to shame; may suffer from depression, isolation, demoralization; and even commit suicide.

Principal Dr. Madhukar Gitte also informed students not to indulge in any form of ragging. In case of such incidence, the concerned students should inform the Anti-Ragging Committee and the Principal.

**Outcome:** Ragging is a very common but very serious issue that still happens in some colleges, sometimes it gets reported if the victim or the junior students takes the ultimate step which is committing suicide, or sometimes if the student is brave enough to say it loud that seniors are ragging on someone.


Students got information about different forms of ragging and the consequences of ragging.

### Outcome:



Day-8- Handling Q&A and Audience Engagement


